Safety Abroad

Going to a foreign country can be exciting, interesting and an adventure. It can also be a risk. Ensuring that you know about the danger and can manage the risk exposure will allow your time abroad to be memorable for the correct reasons.

Money Safety - take only as much with you as you absolutely need during your travel. The less you take with you, the less your loss in case of theft. If possible make use of the traveller's cheque option. If you have more funding options abroad rather than a large sum of cash you are lowering the chance of you losing all your money. Don't carry all your cash in your wallet. Every time you open your wallet, you risk exposure. Hide some of your cash in a hidden compartment in your luggage and your clothing. Keep your wallet in your inner jacket pocket so that it won't be easy to steal it. Carrying a money belt under your jacket is also a good idea. Please ensure handbags are not left unattended and try to ensure that the contents are not visible. Use your debit or credit card to make purchases as much as possible.

Try not to take expensive gadgets with you although tablets and mobile phones are now deemed as necessary, it may be best to leave them behind. If you must take them please

ensure that your insurance covers for loss, theft or damage at your destination.

Unfamiliar Areas - as you would at home please remember to assess the area you are in. Avoid all unlit streets and ensure you stick to main routes. If you do get lost please ensure you do not get into any unlicensed taxis. It may be worthwhile checking out restaurant choices during the day, planning your route to ensure you have a clear idea where you are going while it is daylight.

Holiday Booking Safety - tempted by an ultra-cheap holiday deal? You may be bombarded with deals that promise everything at pocket money prices. But if it seems too good to be true, that's because it may well be. If booking online please ensure that all bookings are made through a secure website that is ABTA and ATOL protected.

Resort Safety - as you will be aware many holiday resorts have been in the news being linked or targeted with various acts of terrorism or government uncertainty. Please ensure you check with the Foreign Commonwealth Office prior to your departure (or booking if possible). If any safety instructions have been put in place please ensure you adhere to them. When abroad always ensure you know where your local consulate office is in case of any emergencies.
