NATIONAL BURNS AWARENESS DAY

Yesterday (October 19th) marked National Burn Awareness Day, with new statistics showing that hair straighteners accounts for almost 20% of burn injuries.

Analysis of hospital admissions data showed the most common causes of burn in 2015 ranged from chip pans to hair dyes. The statistics showed:

- 31% of admissions resulted from injuries related to cooking, hot drinks, soups, porridge and stews.
- 18% of contact burns came from hot objects like heaters, irons, hobs, oven doors and hair straighteners.
- Barbecues, garden fires and bonfires were responsible for 11% of hospital admissions.
- 7% of burns came from fires caused by flammable clothing near candles and cigarettes, flash fires from chip and grease pans and flame burns from building fires.
- 6 % of injuries come from scalds from hot baths, sinks and showers
- 27% of the other injuries resulted in accidents involving chemical burns from fertilisers, sunburn, bleach, hair dyes, cement, acids and alkalis; and other noncategorised burns.

The Children's Burns Trust has provided helpful information about what you should do if you or a loved one suffers a serious burn.

- Cool the burn with running cold tap water for 20 minutes and remove all clothing and jewellery (unless it is melted or firmly stuck to the wound).
- Call for help: 999 or local GP for advice.
- Cover with cling film or a sterile, non-fluffy dressing or cloth.
- Make sure the patient is kept warm.
