BLACK FRIDAY AND CYBER MONDAY

This weekend marks the busiest shopping period of the year, as the high street stores prepare for the festive season with big ‘Black Friday’ reductions.

Black Friday, which this year falls on 25 November, is the day that retailers sell stock at low prices up and down the country. Cyber Monday is also the term used to describe the busiest internet shopping day of the year, which typically follows Black Friday.

While Black Friday and Cyber Monday offer shoppers some incredible savings, it has been reported that this year, cyber criminals are expected to steal more than £18.5 million from UK bank accounts as shoppers flock online, according to a report by comparethemarket.com.

It follows recent findings from the website that one in 10 people have been the victim of a cyber attack on their credit or debit card in the past year, with money successfully removed from the account in 62% of cases at an average amount of £475.



ABSAFE’S TOP TIPS TO AVOID BEING HACKED

- Don’t re-use your passwords - keep all account passwords different
- Combine upper and lower case letters and avoid dictionary words. Don’t forget to use the spacebar in amongst your password, it’s not regularly used
- Try a password manager such as 1Password, which is a programme that can generate secure passwords and store them online for you.



- Use a memorable sentence like: “My mum lives at 62 Green Lane” and use the first letter of each word: “Mml@62GL”
- Change your passwords regularly to keep your details safe

SMOKING IN CARS BAN

A ban on smoking in cars whilst carrying children is to come into force on Monday 5 December in Scotland. The new legislation means that fines of up to £100 will be issued for anyone who is caught smoking in a car which has a passenger under the age of 18.
